What is the Alumnes Acompanyants project?

The *Alumnes Acompanyants* project, created by the Municipal Immigration Service in 2004 is aimed at all secondary education (ESO) students enrolled at any of the secondary schools in Cambrils.

The objective is to encourage girls and boys who have lived in Cambrils for some time to act as guides to other young people who have recently arrived in the town and are attending classes through the *Aula d'Acollida* (newcomers' programme).

What are the objectives?

The objectives are to help the student learn the language, familiarise them with the town and encourage friendship between newly arrived students and other young people of the same age.

Part 4:

What activities do we offer?

The following activities are carried out during non-teaching hours and outside of education centres throughout the whole school year:

- ↗ **Preparation course for young people who wish to act as guides.**
- ↗ **Group leisure activities once a month for the young people involved in the project.**
- ↗ **Partnering of newcomers and guides, with a commitment to meet twice a month.**
- ↗ **Supervision tutorials once a month.**
